Common Phrases for Asking About the Menu

- - 'Can I see the menu, please?'
- - 'What do you recommend?'
- - 'Do you have any vegetarian options?'
- - 'What are the specials today?'










Common Phrases for Ordering Food

- - 'I would like a chicken burger, please.'
- - 'Can I have a glass of orange juice?'
- - 'I'll take the pasta with cheese.'
- - 'Can I get a cup of coffee with milk?'

Asking About the Order

- - 'Does this dish come with rice?'
- - 'Can I get extra sauce on the side?'
- - 'Can I change the fries to mashed potatoes?'
- - 'Is this dish spicy?'

Practice Conversation Example

-  Waiter: 'Good evening! Welcome to ABC Restaurant. May I take your order?'
-  Customer: 'Yes, can I see the menu, please?'
-  Waiter: 'Of course! Here you go.'
-  Customer: 'What do you recommend?'
-  Waiter: 'Our grilled chicken with mashed potatoes is very popular.'
-  Customer: 'Sounds great! I'll take that. And a glass of iced tea, please.'
-  Waiter: 'Sure! Anything else?'
-  Customer: 'No, that's all. Thank you!'
-  Waiter: 'Your food will be ready in 15 minutes. Enjoy your meal!'
