Common Phrases for Asking About Sizes

- - 'Do you have this in a size M?'
- - 'Can I try this on?'
- 'Does this come in a bigger size?'
- 'Is this available in a smaller size?'

Common Phrases for Asking About Prices

- 'How much is this?'
- 'Is there any discount on this?'
- 'Do you accept credit cards?'
- 'Can I get a receipt, please?'

Asking About Colors and Designs

- - 'Do you have this in another color?'
- - 'I like this design. Do you have it in blue?'
- 'I am looking for a formal shirt.'
- 'I need a dress for a wedding.'

Practice Conversation Example

- Customer: 'Excuse me, do you have this shirt in a size M?'
- Shop Assistant: 'Let me check for you. Yes, we do!'
- Customer: 'Great! How much is it?'
- Shop Assistant: 'It's \$25.'
- Customer: 'Do you have this in black?'
- Shop Assistant: 'Yes, we have it in black and navy blue.'
- Customer: 'Perfect! Can I try it on?'
- Shop Assistant: 'Of course! The fitting room is over there.'
- Eustomer: 'Thank you!'
