Basic Phrases for Describing

- 1. **Size:**
- 'It is big.'
- 'It is small.'
- 'It is medium-sized.'
- 2. **Color:**
- 'It is red.'
- 'It is blue.'
- 'It is black and white.'
- 3. **Shape:**
- 'It is round.'
- - 'It is square.'
- 'It is long.'
- 4. **Function:**
- 'It is used for writing.'
- 'It is used for cutting.'
- 'It is used for cleaning.'

Building Sentences

- 1. Basic Structure:
- 'It is [adjective].'
- 'It is used for [verb-ing].'
- Examples:
- 'It is big and blue.'
- 'It is used for cutting.'
- 2. Additional Phrases:
- 'It is made of [material].'
- Example: 'It is made of wood.'
