Using 'Will' for Future Plans

- - 'I will travel next year.'
- - 'We will visit our grandparents tomorrow.'
- - 'She will join the workshop on Saturday.'

Using 'Going To' for Future Plans

- - 'I am going to study English tomorrow.'
- - 'They are going to watch a movie tonight.'
- - 'He is going to start a new job next month.'

Common Phrases for Future Plans

- - 'I plan to...'
 - - 'I hope to...'
 - - 'I am thinking about...'
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- Examples:
 - - 'I plan to travel to Europe next year.'
 - - 'I hope to learn a new skill.'
 - - 'I am thinking about starting a business.'

Practice Conversation Example

- A: 'What will you do this weekend?'
 - B: 'I will visit my grandparents.'
 - A: 'That sounds nice! What are you going to do there?'
 - B: 'I am going to help them with their garden.'
 - A: 'That's great! I hope you have a good time.'
 - B: 'Thank you! What about you?'
 - A: 'I am going to relax at home and read a book.'
